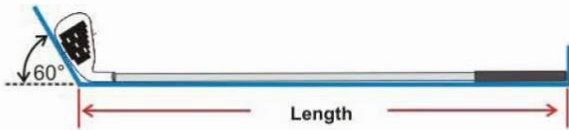
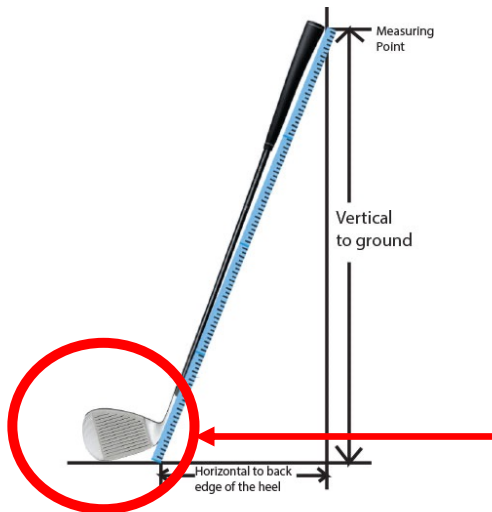


Measuring Club Length

USGA & R&A Rules of Golf Method uses a 60° clubhead angle and measures from the heel of the club to the tip of the grip. I use the USGA certified measuring rules from Golf Mechanix. (shown below)



▲ Raw shafts "Pass through" trimming indexer, doubles up as a grip stop to permit accurate length measurements to be made.



This gets a little tricky since the sole of the club must be centered when you measure. If the toe is either too upright or too flat (as shown in the picture), the measurement can be off as much as 1". Accuracy here is important.
